

Prayers of the Confraternity of the Holy Face

O Bleeding Face, O Face Divine,
Be Every Adoration Thine,
(say 3 times)

Meets at 3:30 pm the 1st Sunday of every month at:

The purpose of the Chaplet of the Holy Face is to honor the Five Wounds of Our Lord Jesus Christ, and to ask of God the Triumph of His Holy Church and the downfall of her enemies.

How to pray the Chaplet

(please kneel if you are able)

Make the sign of the Cross, with the Cross, and pray:

V. O God, come to my assistance!

R. O Lord, make haste to help me!

Then say **1 Glory Be...**

Before each group of beads, there is a large bead. On this bead, pray "**My Jesus, mercy**" then reflect on one of the senses of Jesus, or the wounds of His Face, as you say **one Glory Be...**

On every small bead, pray:

V. Arise, O Lord, and let Thy enemies be scattered,

**R. and let them that hate Thee,
flee from before Thy Face!**

Upon completing the Chaplet, pray on the medal:

V. O God, our Protector, look upon us

R. and look on the Face of Thy Christ!

St. Athanasius said the devils hate "Arise, O Lord and let thy enemies be scattered .." more than any other scripture verse. He added that this always compelled them to take flight.

100 days extra indulgence for every prayer said before a picture of the Holy Face! Granted by Pope Pius IX, Dec. 11, 1876

ACT OF REPARATION
For Blasphemy and Violation of Sunday

V. O God! / **R:** Infinitely worthy of all adoration and love / I prostrate myself at Thy feet, / filled with grief for the blasphemies uttered against Thy Holy Name, / and for the offenses committed against Thy divine worship /and the observances of Thy Church. O my God! This blasphemy is the profanation of that which is most Holy in the sight of Thine inaccessible sanctuary; / it is an attack upon Thine infinite majesty, / an outrage against the Face of Thy Divine Son, / a crime without excuse, without any other motive than that wickedness which hates Thee, O God, / infinitely worthy of all love! We beg pardon, O Lord, a thousand times pardon for these blasphemies. Would that we could prevent them by the sacrifice of all that we are, / or that we possess! At least it is in the sincerity of our hearts / that we desire with all our power / to combat

in the good works practiced therein, as well for the expiation of my sins and for the solace of souls suffering in purgatory. Amiable Redeemer, most sweet Jesus, hide in the secret of Thy Face, all the members of this association. May they find shelter from the seductions of the world and the snares of Satan. Grant that, faithfully keeping all the precepts of Thy law and fulfilling the special duties of their state, they may be more and more inflamed with zeal for reparation and with the flame of Thy Divine Love.

ALL: In order to give still greater increase to the glory of Jesus, dying for our salvation on the cross; in order to correspond to the merciful love with which His Holy Face is animated towards poor sinners, and in order to repair the outrages which the frightful crimes of the present day inflict upon His August Face, the most pure mirror of the Divine Majesty; I associate myself fully and freely, to the faithful received into this pious confraternity. I desire to participate in the indulgences with which it is enriched and

this horrible crime, and for all we hear or know / to offer instantly, / by the merits of the Face of Thy Christ, / our humble and sorrowful expiation.
